

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2009 – 2**

**A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING A GENERAL CITY ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2009 DESIGNATING THE FOLLOWING PLACE, DESIGNATING THE CITY CLERK AS THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AND/OR REGISTRAR AT-LARGE AND THE DEPUTY CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AND/OR DEPUTY REGISTRAR AT-LARGE, AND ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF GRAND VIEW, IDAHO THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The general city election will be held in and for the City of Grand View, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2009 at which time there will be elected two (2) City Council Members to serve for a term of two (2) years, and one (1) City Council Members to serve for a term of four (4) years or until the next election and/or a qualification of their successors.

**SECTION 2:** THE FOLLOWING IS DESIGNATED AS THE POLLING PLACE FOR SUCH ELECTION:


CITY HALL at 425 BOISE AVE., GRAND VIEW, IDAHO

**SECTION 3:** That Helana M. Race is hereby designated as the Chief Elections Officer and Verla A. Robison as the Deputy Chief Elections Officer.

**SECTION 4:** The Clerk, for and on behalf of the Mayor and Council, shall give public notice of the time and place of holding such general city election by posting such notice in three (3) public places. The first notice to be made not less that 45 days previous to the date of such city election and the last posting not more that 15 days, not less that 5 days previous to the election: the notice so posted shall state the polling place and the hours during which the poll shall be open for the purpose of voting will be 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.: said notice to contain such information in accordance with the requirements of Section 50-436 of the Idaho Code.


