

RESOLUTION NO 96- 04  
Owyhee County Commissioners  
Murphy, Idaho

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners having been made aware that a hazard to human life and safety exists in the City of Grandview of such a nature to constitute an emergency;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the County Building Inspector, the State Electrical Inspector, the Owyhee County Sheriff, and the Mayor of the City of Grandview, that the building known as the Bank Club is in danger of imminent collapse, that young persons and transients have been entering said building, that law enforcement personnel have had to repeatedly respond to situations involving said building, that the condition of said building is extremely hazardous to human health and safety, and that the hazardous conditions pose a serious threat to the safety of county residents and personnel;


WHEREAS, the owners of said building known as The Bank Club have not abated the hazardous condition of said property;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners hereby declares that an emergency exists in the City of Grandview in relation to the building known as The Bank Club;

IT IS NOW RESOLVED that steps be taken by the County through its Prosecuting Attorney and the City of Grandview to cause the building, known as The Bank Club to be demolished as soon as reasonably possible, in order to abate the hazard to public health and safety, at the expense of its owners.


